The Green Mountain Youth Symphony offers a 7-day, intensive residential music experience for intermediate and advanced student musicians, August 10-16.

GMYS C.A.M.P. participants work with professional music coaches in chamber groups, private lessons, eurhythmics classes, and orchestra / wind ensemble rehearsals. This week concludes with a concert for family and friends.

GMYS C.A.M.P. takes place at Johnson State College in beautiful Johnson, Vermont. Students share rooms in one of the central residence halls, which includes shared bathrooms on each floor and common spaces. The small campus provides easy access to its excellent facilities, including: rehearsal rooms, practice rooms, Dibden Center for the Arts, cafeteria, dormitories, recreation areas, swimming pool, and social activity spaces. The surrounding area is ideally suited to outdoor activities like picnics, hikes, and games.
